Extra-Curricular Grant Scheme

Overview / Guidance

The extra-curricular grant scheme is run by Carsphairn Community Trust (CCT) and is funded by Carsphairn Renewable Energy Fund Limited (CREFL).

This scheme is available to all children of school age who reside in the Carsphairn Community Council area, and will be run as a pilot scheme this year, 2019

Objectives

To enhance the lives of children living in the Carsphairn Community Council area, by providing funding to enable children to benefit from more learning through extra-curricular activities not currently funded by statutory bodies, i.e. council. It is not means tested.

Eligibility

Children must reside in Carsphairn Community Council area and be of school age. Proof of residency will be required by parent or guardian in the form of child allowance information or a letter from school as proof of ID and age of child.

Payment

Grant will be paid at £250 per child for the year 2019 on successful completion of application form. The payment will be made either by cheque or directly into your nominated bank account by electronic transfer.

Questions

CCT are not aware of your personal financial circumstances. It is your responsibility to take any necessary advice before making an application. Under no circumstances will CCT be liable for any financial consequences resulting from your application under this scheme.

Privacy

We will only use the details you provide to process your application. This will be stored on password protected computer or locked filing cabinet. We will not share this data with any third parties unless required to do so by law or as a requirement of the funders of this scheme.

Application Process

- Application forms will be available from Monday 1st April 2019
- Applications will close Friday 17th May 2019
- Applications will then be assessed
- Payments should be made by late May 2019 - early June 2019
