The money is distributed, in accordance with strict criteria and guidelines, either in the form of grants to help finance projects which will benefit the community, or in the form of grants awarded to students in further education, or adults in vocational training.

The Directors are all local people who give their time voluntarily. They meet 4 times during the year to consider applications for grants. At other times, they are involved in meetings with many other agencies: wind farm operators, wind farm developers and other community organisations involved in negotiating agreements, taking part in community liaison groups, etc.
