

## Carsphairn 28<sup>th</sup> August 1812

Convened this day in consequence of intimation from the Pulpit and letters wrote to the non residing Heritors by the Minister.

Mr McMillan of Holm chosen preces\* the meeting having examined the minutes of a meeting of the 10<sup>th</sup> September 1803 relative to fixing the Schoolmasters salary agreeable to Act of Parliament and other things and as said minutes has from some neglect or other never been signed; this meeting unanimously agreed that the Schoolmasters salary in all time coming shall be four hundred merks Scots\*\* with the School, Schoolmaster's House and garden already built & laid off agreeable to said act.

The meeting also set the school fees in future to be

2/- per quarter for English

2/6 per quarter for Writing and English

3/- per quarter for English Writing and Arithmetic

3/6 per quarter for Latin and any other language (English excepted) and when learning bookkeeping along with any of the other or another to pay in addition to the above rates as much as will make it 5/- per quarter.
