

8 Carrisphairn 9th April 1777

A meeting of the Heritors and Session of Carrisphairn called for choosing a Schoolmaster
Compared James Millan of Barlea who by this meeting was chosen precisely John Millan of Blin
Thomas Moffat of Mustroch Heritors and a letter
from John Madam of Craigenellan directed to
the Session Clerk and also a letter from Thomas
Giberson of Garroch empowering Mr Campbell
Minister to act for him and the whole Session
of Carrisphairn all being present but one
They did all unanimously agree that David
Student at the University at Glasgow should be
Schoolmaster at Carrisphairn for the ensuing
year viz from Whitsunday 1777 to Whitsunday
1778 and the College themselves to give him
Eight pounds Scots and Eight pence Scots of Salary
and also something from the Modified funds if it can
be afforded and the Session of Carrisphairn do
hereby enact that he shall take 2 Shillings each
Quarter for every Scholar that read English and
Three Shillings for every one who is learning writ-
ing and Arithmetick or Latin to be paid at
