Convened this day in consequence of legal
information from the Pulpit & letters written to all
residing & non-residing heritors, written by the
minister, Quintin Mc Adam Esqr of Craugengellan
James Mc Millan Esqr of Barlae, John Mc Millan
Esqr of Holm & Thomas Mc Millan Esqr of Larnblach
Mr Mc Adam chosen Preses, the meeting proceeded
to execute the act for making better provision for the
Parochial School-masters, they unanimously agreed,
That the School-masters Salary should be 300,
merks Scots, and that a rood of land shall be mark-
ed off that piece of land belonging to Greenhead
lock immediately behind the School-house; and
they appoint the present meeting a Committee to have
a rood of land of said ground measured & enclosed
with a dry stone dyke; and

The meeting appoint that the School fees shall
in future be - two shillings a Quarter for English
and writing - and three shillings a Quarter when
also taught arithmetic - and three shillings & six
pence a Quarter when taught Latin or any other
Language (English excepted) and

They order ^{that} a table of such fees signed by the Preses
of the meeting shall be hung up in the School-room

The meeting have elected Thomas Mc Millan Esqr
of Larnblach to collect from the Heritors as directed
by the act the price of the land allotted for the
School-masters yard, when said price shall
