1. **PLEASE NOTE THAT SHEEP ENTRIES WILL NOT BE CATALOGUED. ENTRIES MAY EITHER BE SENT IN ADVANCE OR MADE ON THE SHOW FIELD UP TO 9.30 a.m. PLEASE USE ENTRY FORM ATTACHED HERETO.**
2. No animal may be shown in more than one of Classes 1 to 12 except Class 7. Class 15 is open to Hoggs shown in Classes 2 and 9, Class 16 to Hoggs shown in Classes 3, 5 and 12, and 15 and 16 are also open to Hoggs not previously shown.
3. Sheep from confined classes (including hired shepherd's) are eligible to compete for open specials, including Supreme Championship and Reserve. All exhibits for special prizes must have been entered in one of the appropriate classes.
4. Confined judging to start at 10 a.m. prompt, followed by Open at approx. 11.30 a.m. All sheep (including open) must reach showground by 9.30 a.m. and remain until 3 p.m.
