

Crosphairn 24 Aug. 1812.

Convened this day in consequence of intimation from Pulpit and letters wrote to the nonresiding Heritors by the Minister

John Macmillan Esq^r of Holm
Thomas Macmillan Esq^r of Lambloch
Mr Woodburn Factor for the Tutors & Founds on the estate of Craigenhillan and Me

Pres^d: Mr Currie Min^r of Crosphairn

Mr Macmillan of Holm chosen Pres^d the meeting having examined the minutes of a meeting of 10th September 1803 relative to fixing the schoolmaster salary agreeable to act of Parliament and other things and as said minute has from some neglect or other never been signed; this meeting unanimously agreed that the schoolmasters salary in all time coming shall be four hundred merks scots with the school, schoolmasters house & garden already built & paid off agreeable to said act.

The meeting also by the fees in future to be

2/ per quarter for English

2/6 per quarter for Writing & English

3/ per quarter for English Writing and arithmetic

3/6 per quarter for Latin & any other language (English Excepted) and when learning

bookkeeping along with any of the other branches to pay in addition to the above rates as much as will make it 5/ per quarter
